#### Work / Life - Working for the Lord

**Colossians 3:23-24 (NIV)** Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, <sup>24</sup> since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.

## #1. Be diligent.

**Proverbs 10:4 (NIV)** Lazy hands make for poverty, but diligent hands bring wealth. **Proverbs 12:27 (NASB)** ...the precious possession of a man is diligence.

## #2. Develop a skill.

**Proverbs 22:29 (NIV)** Do you see someone skilled in their work? They will serve before kings; they will not serve before officials of low rank. **Proverbs 16:9 (NASB)** The mind of man plans his way, but the LORD directs his steps.

#### #3. Go the extra mile.

Matthew 5:41 (NIV) If anyone forces you to go one mile, go with them two miles. Ecclesiastes 9:10 (NASB) Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might...

## #4. Bring God with you to work.

**Ephesians 6:6-7 (NLT)** As slaves of Christ, do the will of God with all your heart. <sup>7</sup> Work with enthusiasm, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people. **Luke 6:49 (MSG)** But if you just use my words in Bible studies and don't work them into your life, you are like a dumb carpenter who built a house but skipped the foundation. When the swollen river came crashing in, it collapsed like a house of cards. It was a total loss."

## #5. Don't *quit*.

Acts 20:24 (NIV) ...my only aim is to finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me

**Galatians 6:9 (NIV)** Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.
