#### All That Matters – What the More is For

**John 15:8, 11 NIV** This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples... I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete.

**Blessing** – When God says, "I will give you more than you need, personally.

**Genesis 12:2-3 NIV** *I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you.* 

When your blessing lives beyond you, we call that, "Leaving a Legacy."

Galatians 3:14 NIV Through Christ Jesus, God has blessed the Gentiles with the same blessing he promised to Abraham...

1 Timothy 6:17-19 NIV Command those who are rich in this present world not to be arrogant nor to put their hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but to put their hope in God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment. - Hope in God = provision and enjoyment
- Good deeds and generosity = life that is really *living*

- Firstborn blessing = Firstborn <u>responsibility</u>
- God loves it when we take care of the people *He loves!*
