LIE: Thinking that my purpose and calling is connected to my job.


- #1: Your purpose and calling would then be limited to the <u>extent of</u> your work.
- #2: Your purpose and calling would then be into the hands of another person.
- #3: Your purpose and calling would then be defined by a list of *functions and tasks*.

Why?

1 Corinthians 2:6-10 (NKJV) We do, however, speak a message of wisdom among the mature, but not the wisdom of this age or of the rulers of this age, who are coming to nothing. <sup>7</sup> No, we declare God's wisdom, a mystery that has been hidden and that God destined for our glory before time began. <sup>8</sup> None of the rulers of this age understood it, for if they had, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory. <sup>9</sup> However, as it is written: "What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived"—the things God has prepared for those who love him— <sup>10</sup> these are the things God has revealed to us by his Spirit. The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God.

- God is <u>hiding</u> His full will and plans from natural people and from the devil
- God is revealing our purpose to us <u>by His Spirit</u>, because our natural minds cannot conceive of what God has prepared for us!
