John 3:8 (NIV) Jesus answered... "The wind (pneuma) blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit."

1 Corinthians 2:9-10 (NIV) "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love him." 10But it was to us that God revealed these things by his Spirit.

Take a deep breath

Ephesians 4:30 (MSG) Don't grieve God. Don't break his heart. His Holy Spirit, moving and breathing in you, is the most intimate part of your life, making you fit for himself. Don't take such a gift for granted.
